<b>Goal:</b> Increase knowledge of the use of video in the classroom.					
<p><b>Short term:</b> Learn how to use the United Streaming website. Learn how to incorporate streamed video in my classroom instruction.</p>	<p><b>Impact:</b> Two separate research studies conducted in Virginia and California have shown significant improvements in student achievement for students regularly exposed to digital video technology to support content.<sup>1</sup></p>	<p><b>Current Status:</b> Currently, I show content related videos in my classroom. I am aware of the NTTI teaching methodology that advocates showing short video clips with focused classroom discussion. My school has a subscription to United Streaming, but I do not have a United Streaming account and do not know how to use this service.</p>	<p><b>Strategy:</b> 1) Attend division United Streaming workshop. 2) Attend NTTI to learn more about using video in the classroom and possibly acquire a digital video camera. 3) Research how video impacts student learning.</p>	<p><b>Timeline:</b> Coming school year.</p>	<p><b>Measurement:</b> During the coming school year, I will incorporate United Streaming video clips into 1 or more lessons and reflect upon its impact on student learning.</p>
<p><b>Long Term:</b> Learn how to produce videos and have my students produce videos as classroom projects.</p>			<p><b>Strategy:</b> 1) Attend professional development on using a digital video camera. 2) Attend professional development on video editing.</p>	<p><b>Timeline:</b> In the next two years.</p>	<p><b>Measurement:</b> In the next two years I will create a lesson plan that gives students the option of creating a digital video as a project and reflect upon its impact on student learning.</p>
