Dear Parents,

The Challenger baseball program opened in Bridgewater in the spring of 2001. Challenger is a division of Little League Baseball for children ages 5-18 who have physical or mental conditions that prevent safe participation in other baseball programs. Twenty-four athletes from Harrisonburg and Rockingham County participated in our opening season. For most, it was their first opportunity to play baseball in an organized setting and their joy in being able to participate was obvious. The feedback we received from families and players was overwhelmingly positive. Since that time, Challenger has grown; last season there were forty-eight players on four teams.

Rules are modified in the Challenger program and the focus is always on having fun while learning the game of baseball. No score is kept, each player bats every inning, and everyone plays the entire game. Each player is assigned a buddy who works to ensure safety and success. A soft baseball is used for all games and practices.

The Challenger season begins in early April and continues through the third week in June (a schedule will soon be available on the website noted above). Games are played once a week at Oakdale Park in Bridgewater and last approximately one hour.

Players must be registered by February 15 to be included in the uniform order.
